
FROSTED FARMS BARN RULES

- No smoking in the barn
- Drive Slowly.
- If gates are closed leave them closed; if the gates are open leave them open
- All riders and guests must sign a liability release before handling or riding any horse
- It is a boarder's responsibility to ensure that all his/her guests have completely filled out and signed a release.
- Lessons take precedence in the arena.
- All riders and guest must wear appropriate foot wear while on Frosted Farms premises
- Persons under 18 may not ride unsupervised without trainer's and parents' permission.
- ASTM/SEI approved helmets with chin harness in place must be worn at all times while mounted.
- Tie only to crossties, or inside paddocks or stalls
- It is expected that parents will drop children off for lessons; however, it is not acceptable to leave children for more than two hours without prior arrangement.
- Jumping is allowed only during instruction by Traci Abundis, her authorized assistants or with an adult over 21 years of age.
- Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses.
- Clean up manure immediately. Do not wait until after you ride.
- All horse related issues will be addressed either at the barn or by phone during business hours.
- If you should ride on trails in the area please be especially quiet when near homes, be courteous to our neighbors. Please see management for trail information.
- Do not feed any horse but your own without owner's permission. Do not allow your horse to "sniff noses" with other horses, as this can lead to injuries.
- Please take reasonable care when turning out your horse. Use only turnout areas.
- Each person will implement any instructions or suggestions for safety made by our staff.
